


HOW TO FIND US



Shaded area within 1 hour drive

Highgate is easy to reach from all major routes. **From the A66 East**, 3 miles West of Appleby, follow the signs to Morland for approximately 3 miles and Highgate is on the left hand side, 500yds from Morland village. **From M6 South**, exit junction 39, follow the signs to Shap, 1mile through Shap on A6, take a right turn and follow the signs to Morland. Drive through Morland and Highgate is on the right hand side, 500yds past the village. **From M6 North**, exit junction 40, follow A66 East for approximately 5 miles, turn right, following the signs to Morland.

The park has pitches available for caravan holiday homes and lodges up to 22ft wide, with piped gas, stunning views and wi-fi availability. Second hand, good quality caravans are often available on the park. Highgate offers a long season, 1st March - 5th January. The park is within an easy walk of the quaint village of Morland which has a café/restaurant/shop and the village pub. Central Lakes are easily accessible, Ullswater and Haweswater a short drive.

Highgate, managed and owned by David, Liz and daughter Charlotte, is a luxury holiday home park, set in idyllic countryside on the edge of the Lake District, between the Yorkshire Dales and the North Pennines.



An abundance of wildlife lives on and around the park, including the delightful red squirrel. Our own horses, ponies, donkeys and red deer graze peacefully in the fields surrounding the park.

It's surrounding area offers an array of activities and pursuits including walking, cycling, fishing, horse riding, boating and ballooning, as well as indoor attractions such as The World of Beatrix Potter, historic houses and National Trust properties.



If a more gentle approach appeals, a stroll from the park to the Lyvennet River, or Morland Beck offers a taste of the natural beauty that Cumbria has to offer. Morland's 11C St. Lawrence's Church with its Saxon Tower is well worth a visit.
